2nd edition of Inter Foundry & Inter DieCast Exhibitions closes on a high note

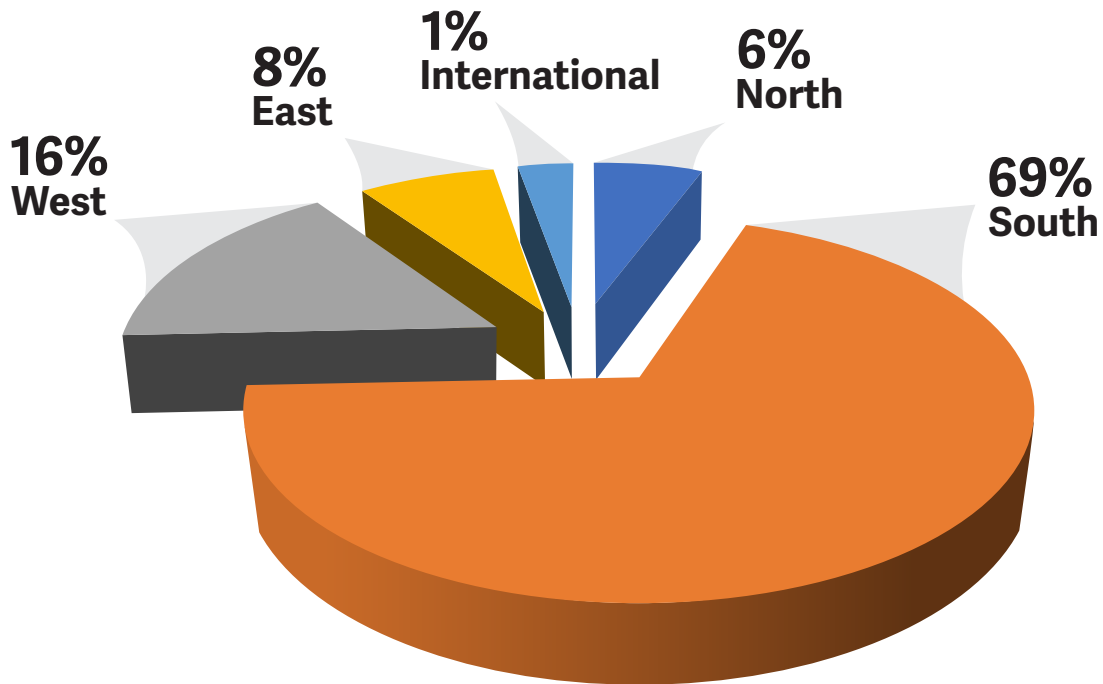

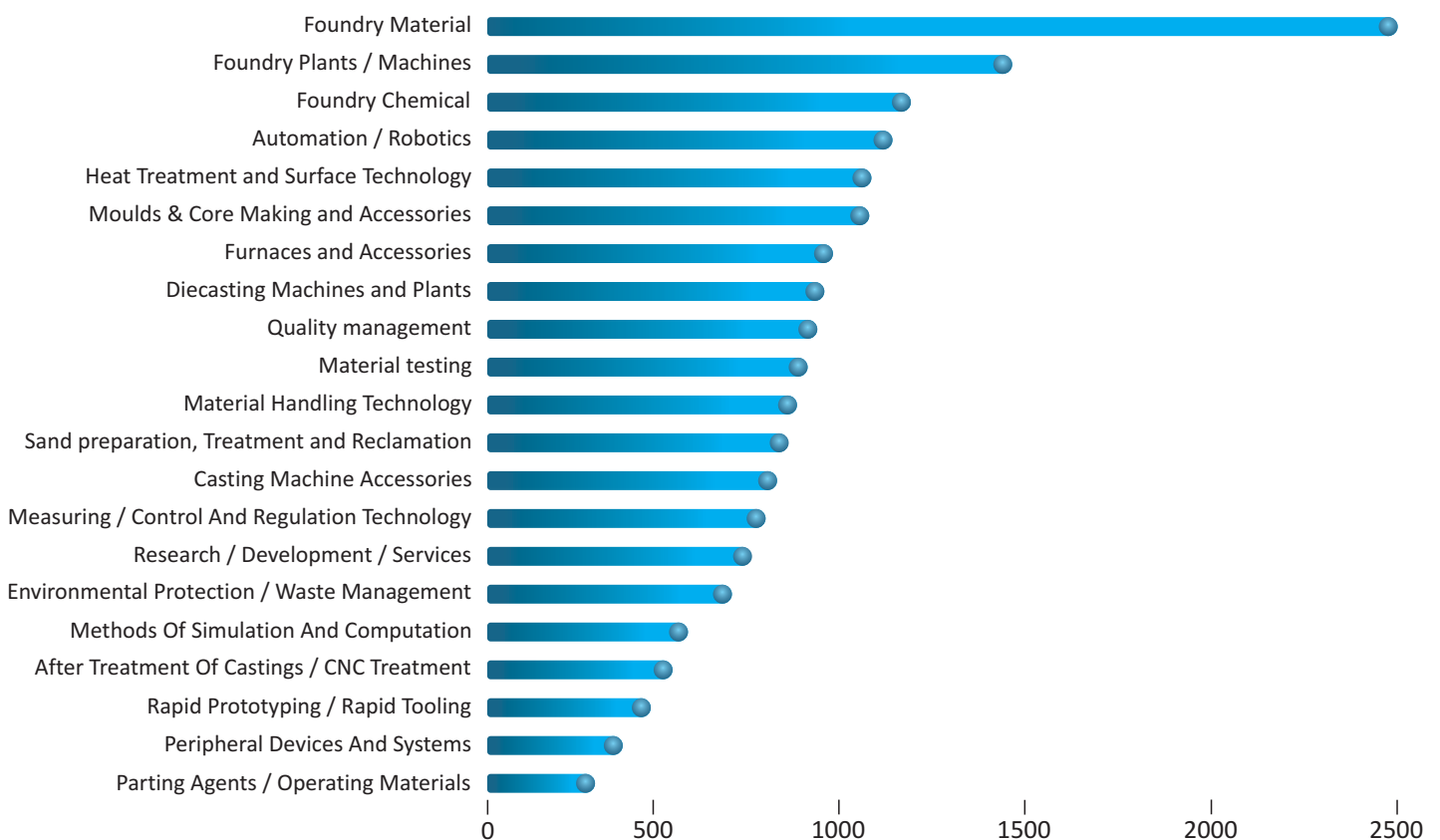

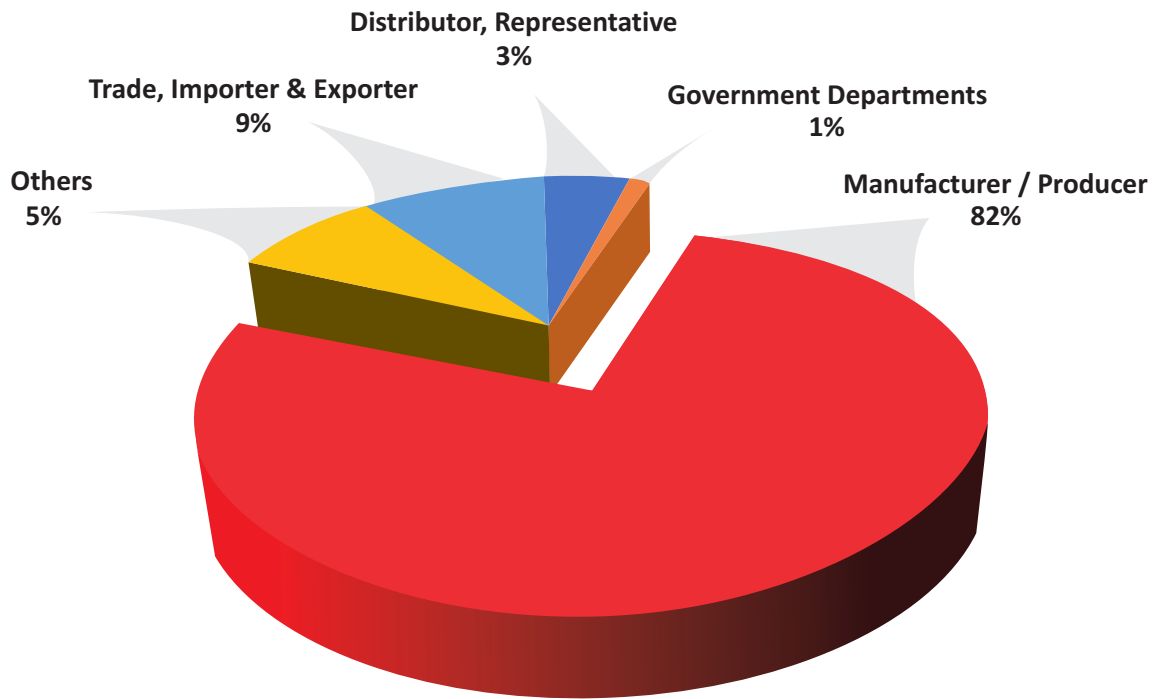
Visitors by Region



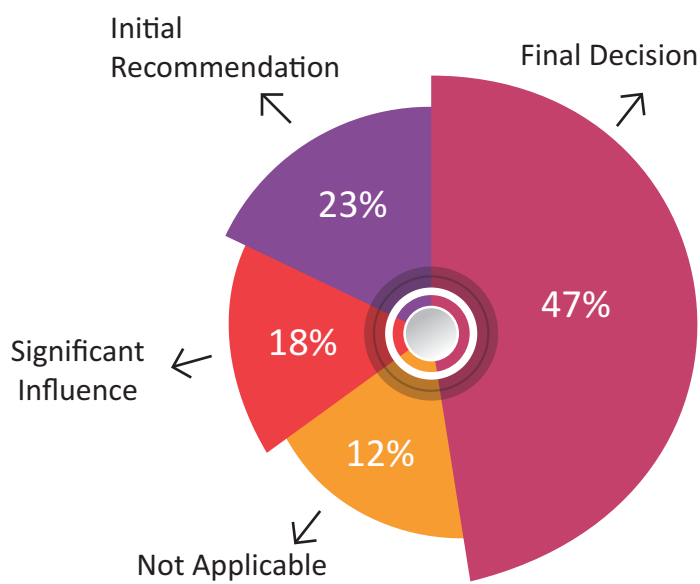
Area of Interest



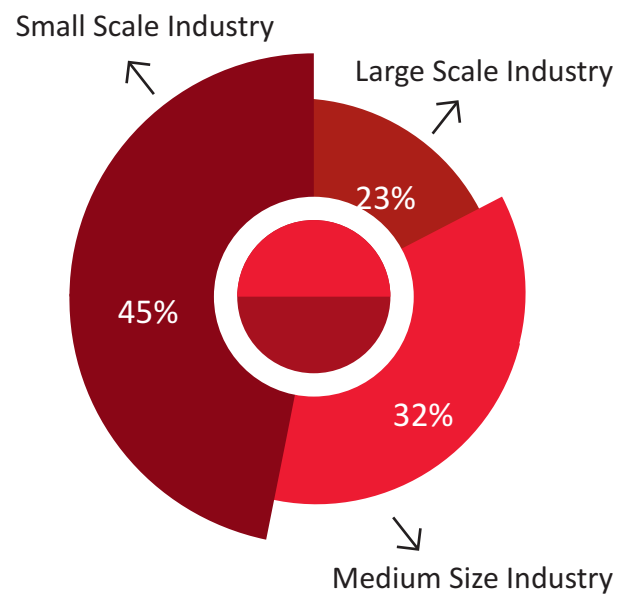
